What is Orienteering

Orienteering is a competitive form of land navigation. It is for all ages and degrees of fitness and skill. It provides the suspense and excitement of a treasure hunt. The object of orienteering is to locate control points by using a map and compass to navigate through the area.

Directions to the Event Centre

Directions: From N17: take R21/Boksburg turn off. Turn left. At first robot turn right into Jan Smuts. Follow through two more robots. At third robot turn right into Jubilee. Turn right into stadium after 450m and follow O signs.

From N12: take Atlas Road off ramp. Turn right. Follow Atlas until it becomes van Dyk. Pass through industrial estate. At M46 (robot) turn right into Jubilee. Turn left into stadium after 2km and follow O signs.

Technical Details

Terrain	Boksburg City stadium and the surrounding areas consist of playing fields, open veld, dams, wetlands and some detailed old mining areas. Vegetation is high in several parts of the area at this time of year and leg protection is advised.		
Map	5-colour map according to ISOM 2000. Re-surveyed and re-drawn by Ian Bratt (ROC), 2017 Scale 1:6000. Contours 5m.		
Timing	An electronic punching and timing system (EMIT) will be used to provide for accurate split and finishing times and easy punching. Emit tags can be hired.
